SERVICES: deployment, integration, custom development, break/fix, managed services


INFRASTRUCTURE: Internet backbone, telecommunications networks, cloud data centers

India is the world's largest sourcing destination for the IT industry with US\$ 124-130 billion market i.e. approx 67%. The IT industry has also created significant demand in the Indian education sector, especially for engineering and computer science by employing 10 million workforces. The Indian IT and ITEs industry is divided into four major segments – IT services, Business Process Management (BPM), software products and engineering services, and hardware. According to the reports of NASSCOM, the growth rate of IT sector is estimated at a rate of 12-14% for the year 2015-16 in constant currency terms and it is expected triple in the year 2025 with US\$ 350 billion.





IT-BPO Revenue Share (Year 2015-16)






❖ Segment wise Domestic Revenue Trends of IT and ITES Industry


